Notes from your town board

Nancy Goss – the **Plan Commission** continues to work on the **Land Use Element** of the **Comprehensive Plan**. We encourage citizen involvement, including attending the meetings, which are published on the town website.

Lou Covotsos – Residents and visitors to our community are fortunate to be served by the expert and dedicated members of the SB/LG Fire Dept. Here are a few of the reasons why:

- CPR, First Aid, and AED training
- Responses to fire and emergency medical calls continue to increase each year.
- We face increasing *shortages* of *volunteer firefighters*. **Chief Hecht** and his team do their best to maintain the same quality of service while they work to overcome increasingly difficult recruiting challenges

Gary Farber – The new sewer pipe on Cedar Shore Road has been installed and new blacktop put down. There is also a retention pond in Will's Park that will catch all of the water from Highway 42 and Cedar Shore Road and then filter it before it goes into the Bay.

Also new is the south pier. It has been completely reconstructed and new boards put down. The next step will be to replace the wiring on that pier and on the east wall of the marina. Mike Kahr is also working to place new sheet steel in the corner where the old sheet steel was undermined.

There is more to be done on the marina. More information will be presented at future budget meetings.
