DEFINITIONS:
 Wooded Roadway = Heavily wooded; or with a significant canopy; or a stand of striking trees or shrubbery; or mature trees close to the roadway.
 Unusual Roadway = Winding road; or narrow road; or gravel road.
 Historic Roadway = Roads with a history of logging, quarrying, or other historic usage; but which roads are themselves physically worthy of preservation.
 Adjacent Natural Attraction = Roads alongside stone fences; or alongside wildflowers or tall grass spreads, or revealing a scenic view of fields or water; but which roads are themselves physically worthy of preservation.
 Adjacent Man-Made Attraction = Roads alongside rural buildings of unusual character; or alongside significant historic buildings; or roads alongside cultural or recreational facilities; but which roads are themselves physically worthy of preservation.
