Notes from your Town Board:

The Town website has a new design in order to make it easier for you to find the information you need.

- Working on an Invasive species ordinance.
- Women's Club Community Ctr - Considering going ahead with roofing the building with money set aside in 2016 in order to keep moisture out until decisions are made on what to do with the building.
- Phase II work at the marina - The Board voted to work with the Finance committee in order to get the needed work done. With improvements, possible revenue could be in excess of \$20,000 per year.
- Ellison Bluff County Park – the board sent a letter requesting that the county plow the park during the winter so it will be more usable all year.
- Community Park – The Town Crew finished the cleanup of the vegetation in the park. Parks and Property would like it “mower ready” by spring.
- Newport Lane – the Town Crew has completed most of the work on the end of Newport Lane.
