Now that spring is here please be reminded that open burning in Liberty Grove requires a permit from the Sister Bay/Liberty Grove Fire Dept. To get a burn permit go to Jungwirth's Ace Hardware at the corner of Hwy 42 and Maple Dr across from the Sister Bay Bowl. Anyone behind the counter can help with this.

Building a fire ring and having fires in the evening is always a fun family event. A portable fire pit with a mesh enclosure to capture hot embers is obviously the safest to use. If you have an open fire pit please remember that your fires should be no larger than a fire that you would cook over and never should be left unattended. This time of year when the grass is brown, it can catch fire very easily and grass fires get out of hand very quickly.

### **Road work in Liberty Grove**

Two heavily traveled roads in Liberty Grove will be getting a face lift this year. One is the entire length of Beach Road and the other is the short road in Ellison Bay from Hwy 42 to the Ellison Bay marina. In Ellison Bay damaged storm sewer pipes are being replaced which will require the road to be torn up. Beach Rd. is scheduled for new asphaltting. While trucks and men are working on these and other roads please observe road and lane closures as well as trucks and workers doing the repairs and installations.



### Recycling in Liberty Grove

In the Town of Liberty Grove recycling services are provided in your real estate taxes. We sponsor a drop-off sight located at Going Garbage Inc at 10564 Old Stage Rd, Sister Bay. Their phone number is 920-854-2114. Items to bring in for recycling are clean paper & cardboard, magazines and junk mail all together and are placed in a container at their location which is marked accordingly. Then in a separate bin you are allowed to dispose glass bottles and jars, aluminum, tin and plastics numbered 1-7. All containers must be rinsed out thoroughly, caps removed and be no larger than 1 gallon in size. Recycling days are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9am until 3pm and Saturday from 9am until noon. This is for taxpayers of Liberty Grove only, both residential and commercial.

### Sister Bay/Liberty Grove Library

For registering you will need proof of residence. The best form of this is a current WI driver's license which shows your Liberty Grove address. A list of acceptable forms can be found on the town web site under elections. You can register the same day as the election but we strongly suggest that you do this before that day. A photo ID is required if you want to vote absentee or when you come to the polls on Election Day.
