ELECTRONIC RECYCLING & PAPER SHREDDING DAY!

On June 18th at the Liberty Grove Town Hall residents of Liberty Grove and Sister Bay may bring in electronics and household appliances they no longer use. There is a fee for televisions, monitors and units containing Freon ranging from \$5 to \$30 dollars. (see web site for listing) At the same time there will be a document shredder here to shred sensitive documents. There is a 5 banker box limit per household/business. Come in between 9:00am and 1:00pm. (Early drop-offs will not be allowed.)

Road work has started in Liberty Grove. Beach Rd, parts of Old Stage Rd, parts of Humbug Rd, & Cedar Shore Rd will all be paved and several roads will receive a chip seal coat. On roads that have been chip sealed drive slowly to avoid excess chips and oil from spraying up on your car. (Chip sealing extends the life of a paved surface.)
