Chairman's Notes

Supervisor Hugh Mulliken was the recipient of Resolution 1-18 from the Town Board thanking him for his years of service to Liberty Grove. After many years of public service Hugh decided not to seek re-election to the Board. Robert Tidball was elected to serve on the Board along with Supervisor Lou Covotsos.

The Board has authorized Administrator Kalms to investigate, purchase and install digital speed signs, upon approval of the DOT, on Highway 42 at the north and south entrance to Ellison Bay. Approval was also given to pedestrian warning signs in Ellison Bay, pending DOT approval. It is hoped that the sign boards will be effective in slowing down traffic and improve public safety, as they have in other communities, in Ellison Bay as well as other areas in the Town.

During research on the Klenke Garage property deed Administrator Kalms came across a description which made reference to the Ellison Bay Cheese Factory which apparently preceded the Klenke Garage on that property. The County will take possession of the property and is expected to turn it over to Liberty Grove this year. If anyone has information on the former dairy please contact the Town Office.

The new NWTC campus has opened in Sister Bay. It is a great opportunity for all of northern Door as we now have an educational and innovation center available close at hand for residents to continue their education, learn a trade, start a business or earn a degree. A ribbon cutting is scheduled for May 7
