Door County Trivia

Door County is among the top cherry producing regions in the country with more than 2500 acres of cherry orchards. The cherry trees normally bloom in mid to late May with cherries ready for picking in mid - July to early August. Door County typically harvests anywhere between 8-12 million per year.

Door County has a large number of local parks, nature preserves and state natural areas that give visitors a variety of options to explore Door County's natural beauty. Add it all up and there is more than 23,000 acres of public and preserved land in Door County to explore and enjoy!

FROM THE TOWN CHAIRMAN

The Town has learned the Premier Resort Tax enacted by the Village of Sister Bay affects purchases outside the Village Limits due to fact the tax is calculated using zip code 54234. If your zip code is 54234 and you receive merchandise that is delivered to your business or home, but not purchased within the actual Village limits, it will fall under the tax due to State Statutes. Questions may be directed to the Town Office or to Tasha at the Village of Sister Bay.

This is also an issue regarding room tax revenues and data reporting. The Door County Room Tax Commission is contacting the Department of Revenue regarding how room tax collecting data is reported since it also is based upon zip codes but not actual municipal boundaries.

The Board and Finance Committee continue to work on the proposed 2019 Town Budget. Informational meetings will be held on the budget. The dates of the informational meetings and Town meeting to approve the budget may be found on the Town web site.

The Town has received signed purchase contracts from the Gills Rock properties. The Annual Spring Town Meeting voted to authorize the Board to pursue the purchase of those properties and bring the results back to Town electors for their approval. The Board has taken the position that any future use of the properties will be up to Town residents as well.

NWTC Learning and Innovation Center

The center has been open over 4 months and is very busy and making progress. They have made so much progress that they have hired additional help. The computer workshops have been popular along with daily visitors checking out the center. The kitchen is busy daily with their food processors'. The center has hosted a number of community meetings.

The Fall classes and registration has had a great response. This Fall classes will be offered for the Supervision Certificate, also included business seminars. They have students enrolled in Business Principles, Marketing Principles, Human Resource Management and many others. The Community Education classes offered include computer, smartphone, wills and trusts, self- awareness and creative thinking. They have developed a space rental program for pop-up shops. Pop-ups are temporary retail spaces that sell merchandise of all kinds. Pop-ups can be used to launch new products, generate awareness, move inventory and introduce collaborations. This idea will be tested in September with a local artist. The food processors will jointly host a pop-up shop in November.
