From the Town Chairman

The Board has named a small road running off of Flint Ridge Road " Flint Ridge Lane" It is approximately 850 feet in length and is just west of the intersection of Orchard Road and Flint Ridge Road. Ordinance 6-19 was enacted to name the road per a state statute that directs Town Boards to assign names to roads within their jurisdiction.

The official newspaper for posting of public notices has been changed to the Peninsula Pulse.

The Finance Committee will be meeting on July 31st to review the finances of the Town during the first six months of the 2019. The meeting is open to the public.

The second meeting of July for the Town Board will be held on Tuesday July 16 to accommodate several other events on the normal meeting date.

David Studebaker, chair of our Tech Committee, has been sharing information regarding proposed low earth satellites intended to bring internet service to rural areas around the globe. Low-Earth orbits range in altitudes of 112 to 1,200 miles. The FCC has approved nearly 13,000 low-Earth orbit satellites. Those include 11,943 for Musk's Space Exploration Technologies Corp., an initial batch of 60 spacecraft were launched in May.
