ORDINANCE 3-96
ORDINANCE REGULATING SNOWMOBILE TRAVEL ON TOWN ROADS

The Liberty Grove Town Board, Door County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section I. Intent.

1. The Intent of this ordinance is to provide a means for persons to travel from a residence and/or lodging establishment within the limits of the Town of Liberty Grove for the shortest distance that is necessary for a person to operate a snowmobile to the snowmobile route or trail that is closest to that residence and/or lodging establishment.

Section II. Definitions.

The definitions of s. 350.14, Wis. Stats. are hereby adopted by reference.

Section III. Statutory Authority.

This ordinance is adopted as authorized under s. 350.18(3)(a) Wis. Stats.

Section IV. Conditions.

This ordinance allows for snowmobile travel by persons residing in or staying at a residence and/or lodging establishment within the limits of the Town of Liberty Grove, Door County Wisconsin to travel for the shortest distance that is necessary to reach the snowmobile trail or route that is closest to that residence and/or lodging establishment subject to the following conditions:

Section VI. Speed.

A snowmobile operated on a portion of the roadway or shoulder of a highway pursuant to this ordinance shall observe roadway speed limits.

Section VII. Enforcement.

(1) This ordinance shall be enforced by the issuance of a citation to any violator of this ordinance by any Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff of the County of Door, State of Wisconsin, by any state of Wisconsin officer with police powers, or by a Town Board member so designated.

(2) In the alternative, any forfeitures imposed by this ordinance may be sued for and recovered pursuant to Chapter 778, Wis. Stats., in the name of the Town of Liberty Grove.

Section VIII. Penalties.

Wisconsin state snowmobile penalties as found in s. 350.119(1)(a), Wis. Stats., are hereby adopted by reference.

Section IX. Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of the ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
